How does Patronage work?

Each year, the Board of Directors considers a patronage allocation based on our yearly financial performance. If a payment is declared, the calculation is based on deposit interest paid to you, as well as loan interest you have paid to us.

It's simple - the more business you do at Lafleche Credit Union, the higher your patronage amount will be!

How is Patronage paid out?

Patronage is paid by direct deposit. The payment may be a combination of a cash payment (into your chequing or savings account) and a deposit into your equity account.
